





What Are The Federal Poverty Levels For 2013?

When applying for many public benefits, often eligibility is based on income and sometimes on assets. The income guidlines follow certain federal poverty levels (FPL) depending on the particular program you apply for. Here is a table of federal poverty levels for 2013. Take a look at these and compare what your monthly income is. Keep in mind that all sources of income will be included when applying for benefits, regardless if the income is taxable or not. Income reported must be the gross amounts, (before any deductions are

For an example: There is a program available for those on Medicare to get their Part B premiums paid for. There are 3 different levels of the Medicare Savings Program and each level specifies a different federal poverty level for eligibility. The qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) level uses the 100% FPL as the income guideline. The other two levels would include persons in the 120% and 135% FPL's.

When applying for the Medicare Part D Extra Help, income eligibility is based on the 150% FPL or less. There again are 4 different levels based on the different levels of FPL that would determine what percentage of the Extra Help Subsidy you would receive. Sounds pretty complicated but we receive up-to-date and tables that give us excellent resources when counseling individuals on the various programs.

The SeniorCare program begins at the 160% FPL and has 4 levels up to 240% FPL. Actually this program is very unique in the fact that there really is no income limit, but depending on the cost of your prescriptions in comparison with your income, you may not use the program. However, it is creditable coverage, you don't have to enroll in a Part D plan for your prescriptions, and your cost is only \$30 per year if you are not taking any prescriptions. It saves you from a penalty!

Food Share is based on the \$200% FPL or less. The Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) accepts applicants who are at or below 60% of the State Median Income Level and not a federal poverty level. The Homestead Tax credit program has an annual income limit of \$24,680 for 2012. Your refund is calculated by comparing tables with income and the amount of property tax or rent paid.





State Patrol warns of phone scam

Caller asks for money to pay for repairs after traffic crash

Wisconsin State Patrol officials are warning about a phone scam in which a caller identifies himself as a sergeant from the State Patrol Green Bay office and asks for money to resolve a car crash involving a relative of the person called.

The State Patrol has received information that people on at least two occasions were called by a man who identified himself as "Sergeant Walker of the State Patrol office in Green Bay." The fake sergeant asked for \$900 to pay for damages caused by the person's child or grandchild in a crash. The fake sergeant said the money, which needed to be wired immediately, would fix the damages so the other driver would not press charges.

"The phone message is a scam, and the State Patrol under no circumstances would contact anyone with such a request for money," says Maj. Brian Rahn, director of the Bureau of Field Operations. "If you receive a scam phone call like this, please notify the State Patrol Northeast Region—Fond du Lac Post at (920) 929-3700."

The State Patrol has investigated the calls, and the scam likely originated in Montreal, Canada.

What Are The Federal Poverty Levels For 2013?

When applying for many public benefits, often eligibility is based on income and sometimes on assets. The income guidlines follow certain federal poverty levels (FPL) depending on the particular program you apply for. Here is a table of federal poverty levels for 2013. Take a look at these and compare what your monthly income is. Keep in mind that all sources of income will be included when applying for benefits, regardless if the income is taxable or not. Income reported must be the gross amounts, (before any deductions are withheld).

For an example: There is a program available for those on Medicare to get their Part B premiums paid for. There are 3 different levels of the Medicare Savings Program and each level specifies a different federal poverty level for eligibility. The qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) level uses the 100% FPL as the income guideline. The other two levels would include persons in the 120% and 135% FPL's.

When applying for the Medicare Part D Extra Help, income eligibility is based on the 150% FPL or less. There again are 4 different levels based on the different levels of FPL that would determine what percentage of the Extra Help Subsidy you would receive. Sounds pretty complicated but we receive up-to-date and tables that give us excellent resources when counseling individuals on the

The SeniorCare program begins at the 160% FPL and has 4 levels up to 240% FPL. Actually this program is very unique in the fact that there really is no income limit, but depending on the cost of your prescriptions in comparison with your income, you may not use the program. However, it is creditable coverage, you don't have to enroll in a Part D plan for your prescriptions, and your cost is only \$30 per year if you are not taking any prescriptions. It saves you from a penalty!

Food Share is based on the \$200% FPL or less. The Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) accepts applicants who are at or below 60% of the State Median Income Level and not a federal poverty level. The Homestead Tax credit program has an annual income limit of \$24,680 for 2012. Your refund is calculated by comparing tables with income and the amount of property tax or rent paid.

These are all beneficial programs to consider when economic and financial stress occurs on household budgets. Awards given for economic development in Forest County

[Crandon] – Chuck Brys, Business Counselor for the UWGB Small Business Development Center, Steven Nelson, Community Development Educator for UW-Extension, are recipients of the 2013 Award for Excellence in Community Engagement and Jim Schuessler, executive director for Forest County Economic Development Partnership (FCEDP) is the recipient of the Friend and Advocate Award from the University of Wisconsin Colleges and University of Wisconsin-Extension.

UW Colleges and UW-Extension Chancellor Ray Cross presented the awards at the institutions' Chancellor's Awards Reception, September 12, in Madison. The annual Chancellor's Awards recognize UW Colleges and UW-Extension partners, supporters and employees for their outstanding contributions to the quality of life in Wisconsin.

In giving the awards, Cross praised Nelson for "leadership [that helped] bring together a rare combination of tribal leadership; town, city, county, state and national resources; education at local and state levels; local libraries and the county health department; chambers of commerce; and various business sectors." He went on to acknowledge Brys for "critical business counseling services to those starting and growing businesses." Cross then cited accomplishments from the past year—"The 2012 result of their groundwork, along with the Partnership led by Jim, includes more than 135 jobs created just in the manufacturing sector alone, totaling a payroll well over \$5 million. Nearly \$7 million in capital was raised in these projects in Forest County."

Forest County Board Chairman Paul Millan attended the event. Chancellor Cross made reference to Millan's sentiments noting "[Paul Millan] credits the three of you for your skills and teamwork leading to 'incredible' results in the first two years of the partnership."

For the September 12 event, the Wisconsin Legislature also presented a citation congratulating the 41 employees and four partners receiving awards, commending "their commitment to Wisconsin by providing valuable services that keep its citizens thriving and our great state moving forward."

The goal of the Homework Help Center is to provide space dedicated to students of the School District of Crandon, and/or area homeschoolers who are working on school assignments.


