Susan Sommer Announces Her Candidacy for State Senate

Phelps - Susan Sommer, Rhinelander native and resident of Phelps, announces her candidacy for Wisconsin State Senate District 12.

Sommer runs as a Democrat for the position being vacated by Senator Jim Holperin, who dedicated years of service to the North.

"It is because of my love for the Northwoods and the inability of our current legislature to promote and protect this area that I'm running for State Senate," Sommer explains. "This recent legislative session, which focused only on partisan politics, has divided and polarized our communities. Our government has acted in violation of the ethics we hold true. As Senator for the 12th District, I will strive to produce legislation that honors our ethics. It is time to stop the partisan politics and work together for the sake of our common good."

Sommer seeks the office of State Senator in order to provide thoughtful and responsible leadership in service to the district's values.

"We believe in a community ethic that demands our children and elders receive necessary resources to thrive and succeed. Sommer experienced the best in public education as a child growing up in Rhinelander, where she attended public schools and graduated from Rhinelander High School in 1978 with honors. "I received an excellent education through the Rhinelander public school system that provided me with a strong foundation for further education and success," Sommer says.

Sommer obtained a degree in Journalism at the University of Missouri/Columbia, with a minor in Spanish, in 1982. She went on to receive her law degree from Marquette University Law School in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in 1987. Sommer began her legal career with the Milwaukee County District Attorney's office and later the Jefferson County District Attorney's office, where she served the public as a prosecuting attorney for a total of 17 years.

As a prosecutor, Sommer endeavored to honor and protect the truth. "I worked hard as an Assistant District Attorney to make certain the truth had a voice in court and that it was heard. For 17 years, I was privileged

Wolf River Tourism Conference May 16-17

On Wednesday, May 16th, the kickoff of the Northern Wisconsin Wolf River Tourism Conference will open in Mole Lake at the Casino Conference Center.

Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday morning. The opening address will be by Benedicte Riis, a Danish author and traveler who is currently writing a book on Wilhelm Dinesen and his 1872-1873 stay at the recently restored cabin at Mole Lake. Dinesen was a Danish adventurer, and his daughter, Karen Blixen, wrote the famous novel and later movie, "Out of Africa."

Following, a keynote address will be delivered by Susan Thering, PhD and Wayne Gannaway on "Building a Sustainable Tourism Economy in Wisconsin's Wolf River Area."

There will be a break from 10:30 till 11:00 a.m. and then a panel discussion on building a sustainable economy in the Wolf River area. This will be followed by breakout sessions on recreation, arts and culture, food and drink, accommodations, retail, and entertainment.

A trade show will be on from 3:00 until 5:00 p.m., and after dinner, the Honoring Veterans Folk Concert. From 8:15 until 8:45 there will be a session on celestial photography, night skies permitting.

On Thursday morning, Benedicte Riis will talk on international tourism and the Danish connection.

A tour of the Dinesen log cabin will run from 10:30 until noon when there is lunch and closing remarks.

The Weight of the Nation:

Groundbreaking Documentary Series on Obesity Epidemic
Debuts May 14 and 15

The obesity epidemic is now recognized as one of the most pressing health issues facing the nation today. To draw attention to the issue, a public education campaign will be launched with the broadcast of "The Weight of the Nation," a four-part documentary series on HBO starting on Monday, May 14.

HBO will drop its subscriber fees during the premier and stream the episodes online at HBO.com, in English and Spanish, to make them widely accessible to the public.

The documentary, three years in the making, takes a head-on look at the severity of the obesity crisis and its crippling effect on our health care system. It is a collaboration of HBO, and the Institute of Medicine, in association with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the National Institutes of Health as an education effort to combat the obesity epidemic.

"We encourage every adult and child in our community to watch and discuss these films. They will give all of us a reason to take action to support obesity prevention efforts like school wellness policies, the creation of safe walking and biking routes and better access to healthy foods," Director of the Forest County Health Department, Jill Krueger, said.

More than two-thirds of U.S. adults age 20 and over are overweight or obese, while nearly one-third of children and adolescents are overweight or obese. Forest County statistics are very similar. If trends continue, close to half of Wisconsinites will be obese in seven years.

Obesity and overweight pose a major risk for serious chronic diseases, such as type 2 diabetes, heart disease, and high blood pressure. These conditions consume 80 percent of health care costs in the United States. Obesity-related medical expenses total billions of dollars each year in Wisconsin alone.

"Obesity is preventable, yet Wisconsin spends nothing on obesity prevention efforts," Krueger said. "We have to take action to stop it. This documentary series is a step in the right direction."

-- Part 3: Children in Crisis. (Debut: Tuesday, May 15 at 7:00 p.m.)

-- Part 4: Challenges. (Debut: Tuesday, May 15 at 8:10 p.m.)

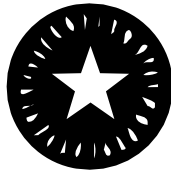

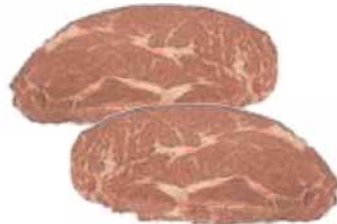

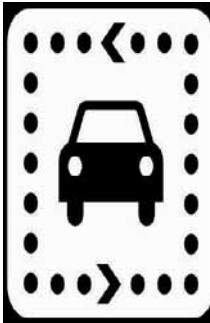
