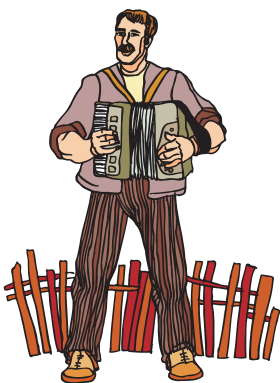

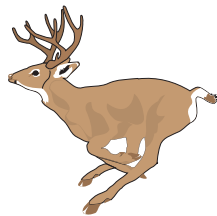

The final report on the deer situation in Wisconsin has been released. Dr. James C. Kroll, the Texan who was hired to look into our deer situation, has been hard at work looking at the problems with deer management in this state.

There are some interesting things on the list of problems to be addressed, including lack of cutting on the Nicolet-Chequamegon, baiting, and including more public input on the process. Kroll and his committee are also pushing for "more boots on the ground" for DNR game managers.

40 Years Equals \$40k for AMSOIL Cup

AMSOIL ups the ante on the America's premier annual short course off-road race

CRANDON, Wis., (July 3, 2012) America's biggest weekend of short-course off-road racing the annual Labor Day Weekend World Championships at Crandon International Off-Road Raceway will end in a decidedly bigger crescendo as Traxxas TORC Series presenting sponsor AMSOIL has announced it is expanding its purse in the namesake AMSOIL Cup to honor the company's 40th anniversary (1972-2012).

Last year at Crandon it was the AMSOIL-sponsored PRO 2WD of Chad Hord (BOSS Snowplows/Nissan) who captured the \$25,000 first-place AMSOIL Cup prize. And should Hord be able to repeat this year, he'll walk away with a cool \$40,000 courtesy of AMSOIL, the recognized innovator and industry leader in synthetic lubricating oils. "Crandon on Labor Day is the absolute pinnacle of short-course racing in the U.S. and AMSOIL is proud to be a big part of the festivities with the AMSOIL Cup race - which this year boasts a \$40,000 winner's purse to make it one of the richest short-course races of all-time," said AMSOIL Race Program Manager Jeremy Meyer. "The anticipation alone for the third annual AMSOIL Cup is going to be off-the-charts."

Founded in 2010, the AMSOIL Cup pits the top TORC PRO 2WD trucks against the premier PRO 4x4 class in a 10-lap battle in which the PRO 2WDs get (roughly) a 12-second head start on the faster-cornering PRO 4x4 trucks. Scott Douglas (AMSOIL/Borla Exhaust/BFG) won the inaugural AMSOIL Cup, with Hord winning last year's race.

Foreshadowing the excitement in store for the fans attending Crandon's fall AMSOIL Cup event was the recent Chairman's Cup race held at Crandon's season-opening Brush Run (June 16-17). The barnburner of a contest saw Ram/Mopar's factory PRO 2WD racer Rob MacCachren reign victorious, albeit surviving a furious charge from PRO 4x4 racer Adrian Cenni (RealTree Energy). Cenni dashed his chances at victory when he blew out a rear tire after leaving the track following a 100 mph straightaway, having made up the start handicap and placed himself on MacCachren's tail.

Added Crandon's Cliff Flannery: "AMSOIL's generosity to the sport of short course off-road racing is well-known throughout the industry and Crandon is pleased to have partnered with AMSOIL over the years. Drivers come from all over the country to race our fall event at Crandon and the \$40,000 AMSOIL Cup race now stands as the largest purse in off-road racing. Our thousands of fans at Crandon will be in for a real treat watching those guys go all out in chasing those dollars!"

Town of Lincoln Building Update

The Town of Lincoln Building Committee met last Monday, July 9, at the town hall. Raash Engineers and Architects were there to present the new plans for the town hall. The changes from the last meeting were made and new outlines were drawn. Raash designed three options for the town hall and community center portion. The committee then was able to vote on the option that they felt was designed the best. All of the options were the same size, but the layout of the space inside differed. The committee felt that Option C was the best designed plan. A motion was made and passed to use that design. Raash representatives needed to know about electrical outlets and air and heat. The information on the electrical outlets were, how many were needed and where they needed to be placed.

The heating and air system was the next topic. The garage will have radiant and forced air. The rest of the building will have forced air. There will be three different systems in the building. The garage will be on one, the offices will be on another and the community center will be on a system by itself. This will allow the town to be able to heat the areas with high levels of use and keep the heating costs down on areas that do not get used as often.

The green outbuilding behind the town hall was voted to be moved by the dump. Bids came in and Wisconsin Public Service was notified. The town had to check to see what the height of the building when it was loaded on the truck. If it was higher than 26 feet, the town would have to pay Wisconsin Public Service to move the electrical lines that would be in the way. The height of the truck and building together was shorter than 26 feet. The committee also looked into a new building. Material only would have cost the town \$17,000. The slab that the building would sit on will cost around \$7,000 and the cost of putting the building together would raise the cost even more. It is cheaper to pour the slab and move the building, then it is to purchase a new building.

The final topic is that the site perked. A test was done and there will be no problem with the well and septic that are in place. A water test will have to be done to make sure that the water is safe for drinking. This does not mean that the well and septic can stay in the place that they are at, but the systems that are in use can still be used.

Feds to Pay Your Utility Bill? It's a Scam Says WPS

Green Bay, WI – A scam that is getting wide attention across the nation involves promises that a new program, often called a bailout, offered by the Obama administration will pay utility bills for customers. The scammers use a variety of methods to contact unsuspecting customers including phone calls, emails, and even door-to-door visits as they attempt to obtain personal information.

Wisconsin Public Service reminds customers never to give out personal information including social security numbers and banking information unless they know with certainty who they are dealing with.

In the scam, customers are told they can register for the utility bill payment by completing information that includes giving out their social security number and other information. Customers are then given a bank routing and account number to use when they pay their utility bill by computer or phone. The payment request isn't automatically rejected by the utility company so it could appear that the payment was accepted. After a few days, however, the fraudulent routing and account number are discovered and the payment removed from the customer's account.

The danger to customers is twofold. Divulging personal information including social security numbers could lead to identity theft and a host of problems as the scammers open fraudulent bank or credit card accounts using the information. In addition, customers' utility bills could go unpaid leading to late charges and potential disruption of utility service.

WPS said it hasn't seen any of the false payments to date but, nonetheless, issues this warning to customers to be wary of the potential.

Update: Imprelis Damage Spread

A recent update on Imprelis herbicide injury and recovery from Purdue University has been released, showing that damage from the DuPont herbicide is more extensive than first indicated and more homeowners are entitled to compensation for damage to plants.

In 2010, Imprelis was released as an herbicide treating various weeds, advertised as a low-risk herbicide with short residual and few side effects on surrounding trees and plants. By 2011, homeowner complaints began to surface regarding damage to surrounding Norway spruce and white pines. Subsequent investigations revealed that Imprelis remains in the soil and root systems of surrounding trees for a dangerous amount of time, causing bleaching in needles and eventual death, despite persistent watering and nutrient treatments. In August 2011, the EPA suspended Imprelis' commercial license and required DuPont to reevaluate the tests the company submitted with the product's certification. Recently, more extensive damage has been confirmed by the Purdue study.

Since being identified as Imprelis injury in 2011, affected plants show more extensive symptoms this year. Plants that showed no symptoms last year but tested positive for the presence of Imprelis are now showing symptoms as well. Removal is now recommended for Imprelis-injured plants; there is evidence that none recover from the damage. Many more species of plants have been identified as susceptible species, as well: blue spruce, deciduous trees, shrubs, and some herbaceous plants have all shown Imprelis injury. Additionally, the herbicide residual remains in dead plant tissue and in the top six inches of soil, but it is unclear whether the levels (which have been reduced by 97% in the last year) are high enough to cause new damage.

Homeowners that see damage after using Imprelis should remove severely affected trees and treat those not killed by watering during dry periods to reduce plant stress, but should not fertilize damaged trees; the new root and branch growth promoted by fertilizers are very susceptible to further Imprelis damage. Watering and pruning out damaged tissue is recommended; planting new trees of any species in the same area is not recommended, as the herbicide remains in the soil.

DuPont has been slow to respond to damage claims; some settlement offers for clients experiencing damage have been processed, but those who have not filed or have not been compensated are encouraged to contact DuPont at (866) 796-4783. Homeowners who believe they may have Imprelis damage to their trees can also contact this number for further information and testing.

Beach Do's and Don'ts

Warm sand, refreshing surf - a trip to the beach can be a true pleasure. A few precautions can keep your experience pleasant and your family safe:

DO prevent dehydration. Bring along water and replenish fluids by drinking repeatedly during your stay. Avoid caffeinated beverages and alcohol as they tend to be dehydrating.

DON'T swim if lifeguards are absent. Even people who are good pool swimmers can get into trouble in open water.

DO prevent sunburn. Block the rays naturally using an umbrella, wide-brimmed hat and sunscreening clothes. Also remember to pack plenty of waterproof, UVA/UVB sunscreen (SPF 30 is preferred, but SPF 15 is better than no protection at all), and reapply after swimming or every two hours. Seek shade between 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., and wear sunglasses with UV protection.

DON'T approach sea life. Stay away from jellyfish (alive or dead) and unfamiliar animals. Shuffle your feet with walking on the ocean floor to give stingrays a chance to get out of the way. Through shark attacks are quite rare, it's best to avoid dusk to dawn swimming.

DO inquire about beach conditions. Check with local officials or access water quality information by state at water.epa.gov/type/oceb/beaches/wherelive_state.cfm#nc. Water quality often deteriorates after a heavy rain, and poor water quality can cause stomach problems and ear infections. Also, learn what beach flags mean at www.usla.org/resource/resmgr/lifeguard_library/flagwarningstandardsilfinal.pdf.

Are you using enough sunscreen? Most people apply only 25 to 50 percent of the recommended amount of sunscreen, according to the American Academy of Dermatology.

Advice: Use an ounce of sunscreen (four dice), and reapply this same amount about every two hours you are exposed to the sun; more often if swimming. Take five minutes to reapply.

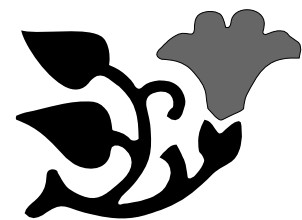

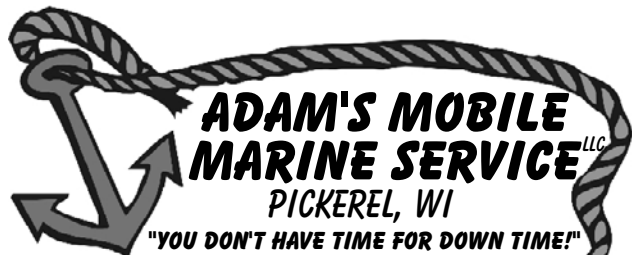


