

Wabeno Area Players to perform "Steel Magnolias" and much more!



Four Crandon Cardinal wrestlers are headed to State! The WIAA D3 Sectional held at Seymour High School this past Saturday was a grappling success for the Crandon Wrestling team with the qualifying of Mason Dewing, Brayden Madl, Elias Gliniski, and Cole Shepherd.

Mason, ranked 10th at 113#, started the day off with a pin over Reedsville in the third period, then a loss by decision from Valders. Mason was able to wrestle back, beating Crivitz by a pin in the first period and then with the ride to state on the line beat Coleman in overtime to secure a third-place finish.

Brayden, 120#, won by decision over Valders in the first round and secured his path to state with a tight match over Coleman in the second round. Brayden finished the day in third place with losses to Manawa in the first-place match and Lena in the second-place match.

Crandon Area Rescue receives new equipment

In 2022, Crandon Area Rescue Squad received grant funds from the Forest County Potawatomi Community and AAA Roadside Responder Safety Grant.

With the money from Forest County Potawatomi, a new cardiac monitor and defibrillator was purchased to replace an older model which was no longer supported by the manufacturer as well as a LUCAS mechanical chest compression device for performing CPR. This allows the rescue squad to have up-to-date cardiac monitors and CPR devices in all 3 of its ambulances.

With the AAA grant, funds were used to purchase a number of new traffic safety vests uniquely identifying the wearer as EMS. Also purchased were a number of specialized multi-use helmets for EMS use during automobile extrication, riding on fire department UTVs or boats, or other technical rescue calls.

Crandon Area Rescue Squad and its members would like to extend appreciation the Forest County Potawatomi Community and AAA for the opportunity to obtain these tools.




