#### **2024 Forest County Conservation Poster Contest**

Each year the National Association of Conservation Districts has a poster contest open to grades K-12 for public, private, or home school students. Each poster created must go through a Local/County contest before advancing on to Area, State, and Nationals. We hosted ours here at Forest County in January and had a good turnout for posters entered. We received 74 posters from students K-12 in the Laona School District and the Crandon School District. The students that took 1st Place at the local level advanced to the Area Contest which was hosted in Oneida County on February 6th, 2024. #### Four Crandon wrestlers qualify for State Tournament

Crandon wrestlers are heading to the WIAA state tournament in Madison! According to Head Coach Paul Cleereman, "The team is sending four wrestlers to the state tournament for the third consecutive year." Cleereman is hoping his wrestlers "make some noise and find the podium." Crandon sent nine sectional qualifiers to Shawano on February 17 and three were able to find the podium which resulted in qualification for the state tournament. Senior Elias Glinski (138#) won his third straight sectional championship and will be making his fourth consecutive trip to Madison; the only wrestler in school history with those credentials. "It's my last year and I'm going to give it all I got to make it to the finals match. My goal is to win the state championship," said Elias Glinski. Taking second and also qualifying, included junior Mason Dewing (120#) and sophomore Cruz Palubicki (165#). Dewing, who is making his second trip to the state tournament stated, "I've worked hard all year and during the off-season and I'm happy to see that it's paying off." Cruz Palubicki stated he's "looking forward to giving it my all and finding the podium." Joining the gentleman in Madison is Crandon's first female state qualifier, Samara Alloway. Alloway locked up her sectional championship by pinning her opponent in 2:17. On heading to Madison, Alloway commented, "I'm excited and nervous at the same time, but I'm also very proud to be the first girl to make it to state in Crandon High School history." The WIAA state tournament will be held at the Kohl Center with action kicking off on Thursday, February 22.

#### Northern Legislators announce Federal Loan availability for small businesses

On Tuesday, Senator Mary Felzkowski (R-Tomahawk), Representative Rob Swearingen (R-Rhinelander), Representative Calvin Callahan (R-Tomahawk), and Representative Jeff Mursau (R-Crivitz) announced that federal loans are available for small businesses that have been impacted by the lack of snow in northern Wisconsin.

"On Monday, 14 of us northern legislators wrote a letter to Governor Evers asking him to work with the United States Small Business Administration to properly declare an economic injury disaster area for counties in Wisconsin that are experiencing substantial economic injuries due to the lack of snow. Today, the Governor and Senator Baldwin announced that some of our counties are still covered under a previous drought disaster declaration - but Florence and Marinette Counties will not have access to these loans unless the Governor declares a new disaster.'

Businesses who have been economically impacted by this drought may submit applications to the US Small Business Administration by visiting the following website: https://lending.sba.gov. These Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDL) are up to \$2 million for actual losses, allow for a deferred payment for the first 12 months, are interest-free for the first 12 months, and have further interest rates that will not exceed 4%. In addition, the loan period has a maximum life of 30 years, but will be determined by your ability to repay the loan.

## The Forest County Referendum details you should know

The Forest County Board of Supervisors approved a referendum question on April 2, 2024, to increase the tax levy limit to cover increased operating costs and balance the county budget.

If passed, the tax impact for a resident with a property value of \$100,000 would be less than \$10 per month. This referendum is a last resort to provide a stable funding source that will allow the county to keep providing core services like public safety, highway maintenance, and social services that our residents expect. These funds will also help cover operating costs that have increased due to inflation and the rising cost of goods and services.

#### **What Happens if the Referendum Fails?**

If the referendum fails, we must evaluate nonmandated services for potential reductions starting in 2025. Mandatory county services may also need to be scaled back as ongoing staffing shortages and other budgetary shortfalls may impact them.

#### **Services at Risk of Reductions** The following are some of the non-mandated services that could be reduced

- UW Extension
- -4H Program
- -Training and other services
- Forest County Fair
- Economic Development Efforts
- -Partnership funding, matching grants, etc.
- Elderly Support Services -Meal sites
- -Transportation for the elderly

#### **Mandatory County Services** The following are just some of the mandated services that could be scaled back

- Public Safety
- -Sheriff's Department, jail, etc.
- Highway Maintenance
- -County and State highway/road repairs, plowing,
- Social Services
- -Child and Adult Protective Services and Juvenile
- -Economic Services: support and screening
- Courthouse Services

-Zoning, Register of Deeds, Veteran services, Treasurer's

Oce, County Clerk, Child Support, etc.

Health Department

-Clinic services and health fairs

It should be remembered that Forest County is unique from other counties because about 17% of the county land supports 100% of the county's operations.

About 83% of the land is owned by government agencies like the Forest Service, and therefore is not taxable.





New EV Hybrid stickers for first responder safety are ready for WI license plates



The Wisconsin Department of Transportation Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will begin sending new EV Hybrid stickers to current owners of electric and hybrid vehicles, as required by recent legislation.

The new law requires that the orange and black "EV Hybrid" stickers be attached to each license plate issued for an electric or hybrid vehicle. Wisconsin had nearly 146,000 electric and hybrid vehicles on the road in 2023.

This Wisconsin law was passed in 2023 for the safety of first responders when dealing with electric powered vehicles in emergency situations. First responders will be able to quickly identify the vehicle as having electric components by the orange and black "EV

All current owners of electric or hybrid vehicles with valid registration will automatically be sent their EV Hybrid sticker(s) and should receive their sticker(s) by June. Starting this summer, those who apply for title and registration for a new electric or hybrid vehicle (including those purchased at a dealership) will be provided a sticker(s) with their new plate(s). Anyone who purchases an electric or hybrid vehicle ahead of that time will receive their sticker by mail. There is no need to contact the DMV for EV Hybrid stickers.

#### Sticker placement

For standard-sized license plates (auto, light truck, etc.): the sticker should be attached to the upper right corner of each plate, just to the RIGHT of the bolt holes.

Wisconsin DMV has streamlined this process for customer ease. More information on all DMV services is available at wisconsindmv.gov.


