

# CJ Greaves wins big at The Big House

TORC: The Off-Road Championship presented by AMSOIL capped another incredible season of shortcourse off-road racing on Saturday at Crandon International Off-Road Raceway.

CJ Greaves was the big winner this season, taking home both the PRO 4WD and PRO 2WD TORC Series titles for the second year in a row with a pair of Crandon podiums. Kyle Hart finished second in Saturday's Atturo Tires PRO Light race to lock down his first-ever TORC Series title.

And the TORC Series awarded PRO UTV championships for the first time as record fields took to the historic Crandon track.

PRO 4WD

It was CJ Greaves who topped the championship standings after 13 rounds of close PRO 4WD competition this season, but his father Johnny Greaves earned the win on Saturday in a nail-biter of a finish. Father and son battled side-by-side to the line, with the elder Greaves taking the win by a scant .088 seconds.

Said CJ Greaves at the finish: "We came through the pack and made a couple good moves and once I got by my dad, I said: 'Alright, let's go!"

Johnny Greaves got the holeshot while CJ Greaves bobbled, and had to make his way through the pack from fifth. He was up to second by the competition yellow and, on the restart, it was Greaves vs. Greaves to the

"We can't ask for a better battle," said Johnny Greaves after the race. "I know he's a little bit better than me, but I still know I'm good enough to hold him off, and I just gotta cover the right lines and not make mistakes."

Visiting driver Patrick Clark rounded out the podium, finishing in third.



# Great Lakes Wolf Summit Sept. 15-from page 1

State Sen. Tom Tiffany (R-Hazelhurst) and Rep. Adam Jarchow (R-Balsam Lake) have announced additional speakers for the Great Lakes Wolf Summit, which is set to be held at Das Lach Haus, 1788 Elm St., Cumberland, on Thursday, September 15, starting at 8:30 a.m. The summit will bring together concerned citizens, policymakers and sportsmen from Minnesota, Michigan and Wisconsin to discuss wolf management.

Tiffany and Jarchow recently announced the addition of speakers Kurt Thiede, deputy director of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, and Bruce Mahler, the Marenisco, Mich., police chief.

Prior to the appointment as deputy director, Thiede was the division administrator for the DNR Land Division for four years. He began his career with the department in the wildlife management program as an LTE in 1999. In his time with the agency, he has served as the wildlife management regulation and policy specialist, the DNR liaison to the Wisconsin Conservation Congress and a customer service and licensing program supervisor for southern Wisconsin. Thiede has a Bachelor of Science Degree in wildlife biology from UW-Stevens Point. Thiede and his wife, Keri, live near Lake Wisconsin with their three children, Claire, Andrew and Logan. When not working he enjoys hunting, fishing, camping, canoeing, hiking and family outdoor adventures in Wisconsin's

Mahler is the Marenisco, Mich., police chief for Marenisco Township located in Gogebic County in the western Upper Peninsula of Michigan. It the second largest township in the state of Michigan with a population of approximately 700.

Mahler has been with the Marenisco Police Department since 2004. When problems such as wolves roaming in town arises, he is the one who answers the call. For a township the size of Marenisco -- 336 square miles -- that can be challenging. He has been working with state and local officials to ensure the safety of the community, as well as the proper management of the wolf population in the UP.

Previously announced speakers are Ted Lyon, author of "The Real Wolf"; David Ruid, wildlife biologist at USDA-APHIS wildlife services; and Don Peay, founder of Sportsmen for Fish and Wildlife.

The Great Lakes Wolf Summit is a free event.





Travis Dinsmore got it by a nose in a three-wide finish with Hart and Kyle Kleiman, who came into the final weekend of the season on a four-race hot streak.

"We had a tight finish there and [Hart] gave me a nasty little punt there after the checker, but here we are in the No. 1 spot and we're good with that," said Dinsmore after the race.

The three podium finishers ended the race the way they started, as Dinsmore took the holeshot over Hart. Last year's Crandon winner Cam Reimers and 2010 class champion Casey Currie battled for third in the first couple laps, but Kleiman held them off to the podium.





The board respectfully asks that comments remain focused on the topic or issue being brought to the board's attention, but not on specific personnel, as personnel is handled through other avenues. No more than 15 minutes will be provided for citizens' comments. If more than one person wishes to comment, the time will be divided between/amongst those individuals wishing to comment.





## Nicolet College Hire Up event Sept. 16 focuses on helping veterans succeed

Making the transition from a war zone to the world of work or the college classroom is often a challenging proposition for military veterans.

David Chrisinger is an expert on the subject and has worked with countless veterans to help smooth reentry into civilian life. He'll share insights he's garnered to aid this process during a special Hire Up presentation from 8:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. Friday, September 16, in the Northwoods Center at Nicolet College.

"Some of the biggest challenges veterans face are isolation and being disengaged when they get back home," said Chrisinger, an associate lecturer at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point and instructor for the course he created, Back from the Front.

He also served as editor of a recently-released book See Me For Who I Am, a collection of 20 stories written by student veterans, most of them from northern and central Wisconsin.

"For many veterans, they're much more comfortable writing about their experiences than they are talking about them," said Chrisinger, a Rhinelander native. "What I've tried to do is give veterans a platform to do this, to express themselves and to let civilians know what their military experience was like."

The presentation, which is free and open to the public, will focus on how employers and education professionals can better understand veterans' perspective and also offer approaches and strategies that are useful in helping them make the transition to a new chapter in their lives.

Chrisinger teaches graduate students at the Bloomberg School of Public Health at Johns Hopkins University and serves as a senior communications specialist at the U.S. Government Accountability Office.

He also started the popular website Stronger at Broken Places for student veterans to write about and share their military experiences.

The Hire Up event at Nicolet will start with checkin at 8:30 a.m., Chrisinger's presentation Lessons I've Learned about Reintegration from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., and a question and answer session from 10:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. No registration is necessary.






